INTRODUCTION

Born and raised on a council estate in Leeds, Yorkshire.

KUILL
SINGER / SONGWRITER

Kuill (*pronounced Quill*) is a workhorse who has made his way up from humble beginnings to collaborating and performing alongside many big names.

As a fully independent artist and songwriter, Kuill has achieved some major feats professionally and personally. Writing & producing his own records, organising his own tours and achieving official charts placings.

In short, Kuill has toured every major theatre in the UK, including a residency on **Londons West End**. He's performed live for **80,000 people at Twickenham** and live on the BBC. He won **BBCs Let It Shine** in 2017 and was applauded by **Gary Barlow** who called his vocal technique a '*masterclass*'. Many years later he was coached by **Sir Tom Jones** on **The Voice UK**, who said he possessed a storytelling voice that was '*special, warm and tender*'. He also supported Russell Crowe and MTV Manchester on tour before his own sell out 'mini tour' of his second album.

His second album '**Fragile Creatures**' boasted co writes with **John Beck** (*Tasmin Archers' Sleeping Satellite*) and **Steve Chrisanthou** (*Corinne Bailey Raes' Put Your Records On*) - It achieved **#1** in the Pop Albums iTunes Chart, **#3** in the Overall Albums Chart and **#31** in the Official Charts album sales. Entirely independently.

With his latest EP '**The Green Time Machine**' and a home grown team, he has just finished a self funded **37 venue UK Tour**, with it achieving **#24** in the Official Charts album sales, as well as **#1** best selling pre-order for 6 months running.

Outside of his own music Kuills' songwriting and composing has seen him amass over **20 million streams** across his writing projects, including working with **Matt Cardle**, **Leona Lewis**, **Callum Beattie** and many international artists. Kuill possesses a very loyal and committed fanbase whom have supported his career as an independent musician to the fullest extent.

Kuill is currently penning his third album ambitiously titled '**Sonder**' it promises a complete rebrand both visually and sound wise, leaning into the Soul/ Pop Electro genre.

INFLUENCES & MOTIVATION

Kuill would describe himself as the love child of **Brandon Flowers & Paloma Faith** with the drive and professionalism of **Tina Turner**

He was massively inspired and influenced by **MIKA** growing up which informs his songwriting and the way he crafts music. He also attributes his stylistic approach to his other favourite artists:

Emeli Sande, Alicia Keys, George Michael, KD Lang, Jamie Cullum and Queen.

Amongst modern contemporaries Kuill compares his lyrical style to that of Sam Fender and Jack Savoretti, and his intentions production wise to that of Chappel Roan, RAYE and Coldplay.

Kuill's motivation as an artist is to create timeless records with overarching themes and concepts that convert well to live performances. His live showcases normally pack quite a punch often including live strings, horns and full ensemble performances.

Kuill knew he wanted to be a songwriter when he heard '**The Element of Freedom**' by **Alicia Keys**, his favourite album.

Entering adulthood, Kuill evolved his production and writing style upon hearing and falling in love with '**The Desired Effect**' by **Brandon Flowers**.



With 16 years of music industry experience Kuill, real name Curtis, has been writing music since he was 14. Raised in a council estate, with his 5 siblings he knew he wanted to perform and write music and was prepared to work hard to do so. He began performing at weddings and christening where he saved enough money to buy studio equipment. After winning a national TV Show back in 2017 and being applauded by Gary Barlow, Kuill toured the entirety of the UK in the fastest selling musical of all time 'The Band' by Tim Firth, and then went on to perform a sold out west end run. Also getting the opportunity to perform at the Elton John Aids Gala in London who applauded the show and told him "You have a fantastic voice, you bitch".


Kuill has also been an international songwriter and tv/film composer since a young age having written over **800 songs** and worked with artists such as Matt Cardle, Leona Lewis, Callum Beattie and Ray Quinn. Yorkshire born, Kuill has made a significant name as a writer both sides of the Atlantic, using many pseudonyms and racking up an impressive array of collaborations equalling over 20 million streams.

Kuill took some time away from the industry to adopt a little boy and write his second album 'Fragile Creatures'. Once his son was old enough for nursery, Kuill decided that he was ready to re ignite his desire for a touring music career with a new a stage name that paid homage to his background. He also put together a large ensemble and toured the country performing a self funded 'Storytelling' show. Kuill is a no nonsense artist, everything he does, he does himself. He finds a way through hard work and determination to achieve things not normally in the reach for someone from his background. He takes inspiration from **Diane Warren** who championed herself into success.

Upon his return to touring work he was personally asked to be the support act for Russell Crowe. He soon found himself appearing on The Voice UK and being poached by Sir Tom Jones. Kuill thought this would be a brilliant way to promote his second album. Kuill went on to perform God Save the King and Jerusalem at this the 2024 rugby games live on the BBC and at Twickenham to 80,000 people.

Not a huge fan of social media in general, Kuill took the step to use Instagram as his main fan interaction platform, releasing cover videos, behind the scenes and snippets of his tours and corporate work. Through tagging artists in his covers and getting reshares and support he has managed to grow his following organically to over 25k! This includes **Sam Ryder, Gabrielle** and **Blue!**

In Kuills' personal life he is a proud Dad of a now six year old who he adopted with his husband. He also owns a rugby club and a small recording studio. Writer of Doctor Who, Years and Years, It's a Sin and Nolly: **Russell T Davies** admirably calls him 'a one man industry'. *Kuill is a shining example of success as an independent artist.*
